Create your own design and then use the Brother PrintModa Studio fabric printer to print it directly onto an 8x8" piece of cotton for your next sewing project.

Learn how to use generative AI technology to create a statue of yourself! You may bring a photo of yourself on a flash drive, or we can take the portrait during the program. The finished 3D print will be ready for pickup at a later date.

This tutorial uses bookbinding techniques to create a handheld folding fan that looks like a hardcover book when folded shut.

Make your own custom resin Dungeons and Dragons dice set AND a dice tower from laser cut parts.

Create a design in CorelDRAW to etch onto a glass vase using the laser cutter.

Create your own beautiful full-color jigsaw puzzle. If there is a specific photo you want to use, please bring it on a flash drive.

Use a 3D printed template to embroider a simple rainbow pattern.

Use resin and an acrylic template cut on our laser cutter to make a stunning faux stained glass piece.

Learn how to needle felt by hand and with the needle felting machine to create a 2D beachscape out of wool on a felt background. Needle felting uses a barbed needle to mat fibers together, typically in wool.

Ever wonder exactly what is in the Collaboratory (or what the Collaboratory even is)? Come to this class and learn about each and every thing in there!

This class will cover how to use the Ditto Pattern Projector, which uses digital sewing patterns rather than paper, saving time and effort while reducing waste. There will also be a demonstration on how to use the software which allows for customization of the patterns before they are sent to the projector.

Interested in learning how to create different types of visual content for personal use or your business, but don't want to purchase expensive software? In this class you can learn the basics of Canva, a free, webbased graphic design program that provides templates and graphics to help users create professional looking documents, social media posts, presentations, and videos.

Learn the basics of Tinkercad, a beginner-friendly computer-aided design software, to make your own 3D models. We will also go over how to prepare these files for printing in Bambu Studio, a slicing software for our new Bambu X1-C 3D printer.
